AS WE GATHER



Sunday, "the eighth day of the week," is celebrated by Christians as the first day of the eternal life into which they were baptized. Today, the beginning of the great and Holy Week of Lent, we begin with the note of great joy as the crowds receive Jesus entering Jerusalem. This will be the last time He comes to the holy city. For we then follow Him to the judgment hall, the cross of suffering, and the fearful tomb of death. The penitential season of Lent concludes with the three holy days, the Triduum of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday. Let us follow our Lord and allow Him to take our sins upon Himself that we may receive His new life in the forgiveness of our sins and the joy of the resurrection.

PRAYERS OF PREPARATION:

Lord Jesus Christ, on the first Palm Sunday you entered the rebellious city where you were to die. You rode over the cloaks and under the branches, You rode through the shouts and past the praises, Receiving the praise that you deserved, but not confusing our praise in your presence for your purpose in coming. O Lord, you rode on. You rode towards the controversy and the cost, You rode towards the curses and the cross, Receiving the stripes you didn't deserve, to give us a reward that we couldn't earn. O Lord, you rode on. You rode through the tomb and the grave, You rode through our time and space, Ascending to a throne that will never decay, A priesthood that will never pass away, A life of love that will always remain, and hearing us even now as we pray. O Lord, you rode on. We remember the journey you have taken as we commit ourselves to walking in the same way. Give us the strength, hope, and joy we need as we follow. In your name we pray, Amen.

As the people spread their coats palm branches on the ground to welcome Jesus into Jerusalem, so we welcome him into our lives this afternoon on this Psalm Sunday. Today, together with the whole church, we begin this holy week by welcoming our Messiah and we hope that each person present will feel the overflow of love from our hearts. So, like the people of long ago, let us follow Him to the cross. Ride on, Ride on in Majesty! Friends of God, let us worship! Welcome!

We gather outside to receive palms and process into the church.
